


January 4 - 7, 2024

Founders Hunt | Valley Park, MS

Valley Park Plantation in the Mississippi delta is where it all began in 2012 when a group of combat wounded veterans were sitting around a campfire and Greg Williams commented that this is what he needed. He continued that he could work with a PHd certified counselor all day and not come close to the therapeutic value of sitting around a campfire with others that had been there. Dan Fordice responded, "well then we will build a bonfire!" Now more than ten years later we are building bonfires across the country offering thousands of therapeutic experiential retreats, and the first one every year is the Founders Hunt.

February 4 - 10, 2024

Colorado Winter Adventures | Granby, CO

Colorado Winter Adventures is our longest retreat and nearly our longest running retreat annually at 12 years. Hosted at Granby Ranch Resort in Granby, CO, with lodging on the slopes, this mountain/area provide a wonderfully supportive environment to learn to ski. WBP partners with the National Sports Center for the Disabled to assist teaching members with prosthetics to ski, snowboard, or sit ski, while the rest work with a private instructor. Learning new things is incredibly good for those living with traumatic brain injuries, and learning collectively in a group together creates an overwhelming sense of joy for others' success along with your own.

February 15 - 18, 2024

Sawblade Outfitters Hunt | Macon, GA

This venue and its generous owners were introduced to us through a connection at The Barn Group and after our first retreat there in 2023, Sawblade Outfitters quickly signed on to host an annual event. This venue is beautiful and comfortable for our members and has a spectacular outdoor kitchen and dining area adjacent to a supreme firepit with seating. The hunt consists of a night time thermal pig hunt, duck, quail, and pheasant hunting during the days, and fishing on the side. The host Kenny and Debbie McCrimmon open their doors to provide lodging, food, hunting licenses, and hunting & fishing equipment.



March 14 - 18, 2024

Bataan Memorial Death March | White Sands, NM

The Bataan Memorial Death March spans 26 miles in the desert, uniting thousands of military personnel (active duty, veterans, and civilians) to honor the approximately 10,000 prisoners of war who died, including 1,000 Americans, under Japanese captivity. For participants from the Warrior Bonfire Program, this event is a chance to set goals, train as a team, and overcome challenging conditions like extreme temperatures and diverse terrain. Many marchers have overcome significant physical challenges, including prosthetics and severe injuries, defying initial expectations of never walking again. Since 2017, the Warrior Bonfire Program has actively participated in the march, also visiting White Sands National Monument, touring White Sands Missile Range, and meeting survivors of the 1942 Bataan March.









March 15 - 18, 2024

Lake Sam Rayburn Fishing | Jasper, TX

Eight years and counting the WBP has been hosted by our now Chairman of the Board, Keestan Cole, at Lake Sam Rayburn for an incredible fishing excursion. The lakefront home offers a beautiful view allowing for the perfect balance of rest and relaxation when not on the water. Every morning a Purple Heart participant is matched with a professional fishing guide and taken out on the lake to learn new skills and techniques to achieve success at an activity that opens the doors to greater healing. The benefits of fishing are both mental and physical. Mentally it offers a connection with nature through serenity, fresh air, and rhythmic motion allowing for reduced stress, depression and anxiety. Physically it provides exposure to sunlight for vitamin D, it is a low impact exercise improving cardiovascular health, improves cognitive function through problem solving and lifelong learning.



March 22 - 25, 2024

Leaders Retreat | Valley Park, MS

The Warrior Bonfire Program is dedicated to empowering Purple Heart recipients on their healing journey. Through the Beyond the Bonfire Program, alumni can give back as Bonfire Leaders. In Valley Park, MS, veterans gather amidst natural beauty for workshops in personal growth, leadership, and community service, guided by experienced mentors. These leaders, with firsthand experience of member challenges, play a crucial role in the program's success.

The leader program ensures consistent, high-quality retreats, meeting member expectations. When a Purple Heart recipient recommends the Warrior Bonfire Program, they ensure a supportive environment for their fellow veterans.



April 2 - 6, 2024

Georgia Fish & Turkey | Lula, GA

The concept of a bucket list often takes on a profound significance for those who have faced mortality firsthand. For veterans who have lost friends in combat or have come perilously close to losing their own lives, the Warrior Bonfire Program offers a chance to check off items from that list in a spirit of celebration and defiance. Who would have thought you could camp and hunt on the grounds of a raceway, but that's just what Purple Hearts got to do on the Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta in a private campsite provided by Chapman Fence Company. With a gated privacy fence erected in no time, they weren't there to watch races, but to turkey hunt, fish, and even take a spin in the pace corvette!



April 4 - 8, 2024

History & Hockey Adventures | Norfolk, VA

History & Hockey in Norfolk, Virginia took us back to the very early days of our nation to the time of the American Revolution at Colonial Williamsburg. Here, hearts were set on fire by Thomas Jefferson and Marquis de Lafayette, by reminding us that the republic must be defended and that the principles of the Declaration of Independence still hold true today. The next stop was the USS Wisconsin, one of the US Navy's largest and last built battleships, followed by climbing the 191 steps of the Cape Henry Lighthouse at Fort Story. Lastly, as guests of the Norfolk Admirals Hockey organization the group cheered the team to victory after receiving a standing ovation when introduced over the jumbotron.











April 11 - 15, 2024

Couples on the Coast Adventures | Gulf Shores, AL

The Couples on the Coast Retreat aims to enhance marital awareness through fun activities, communication tools, and shared experiences with others facing similar challenges from combat wounds. In a small group setting, married couples explore their love languages (Words of Affirmation, Quality Time, Receiving Gifts, Acts of Service, or Physical Touch) which sparks meaningful discussions and mutual understanding. The retreat focuses on fostering happiness, health, and marital longevity, recognizing spouses as crucial support networks. In addition to sessions, activities include a Segway eco-tour, surf fishing, visits to Fort Morgan and the Naval Museum, and romantic sunset strolls are required and greatly enjoyed by all.

April 19 - 23, 2024

Talladega Superspeedway | Talladega, AL

The idea that spending time at a NASCAR race weekend at Talladega Superspeedway and Dirt Track with thousands of people potentially acting badly could be therapeutic doesn't really make sense, but we have witnessed it firsthand! Surprisingly the environment provides opportunities for bonding and connection as well as being able to work through anxiety tendencies while being among those that can recognize signs and assist if needed. As VIP guests of Big Machine Racing, Our Motorsports, and World of Outlaws Late Models WBP Purple Heart Members are given access to secure locations with smaller crowds and no alcohol, driver introductions, lots of swag, and even honorary name and logo decals on cars. For members who never considered themselves much NASCAR fans, the unique experience and great support on this bonfire has left many craving more.



April 25 - 29, 2024

Wisconsin Turkey Hunt | St. Croix Falls, WI

Working in partnership with the Wisconsin DNR this retreat centered around learning to hunt turkeys. Each member was assigned a guide for each outing. The guide's goal was to harvest one turkey per hunter but for visiting Purple Hearts, those goals were very different. They set out for peace and quiet, a chance to decompress, and to once again be on a mission. Prize turkeys were harvested and the joy and thrill of a successful hunt by many was outstanding. However, they were all surprised by what transpired between the guide and the veteran. Relationships, understanding, mutual appreciation and respect.

May 3 - 6, 2024

Healing Through Homesteading | Daphne, AL

A full-on homesteading property in south Alabama hosted Purple Heart spouses for an incredible experience. For those burdened by the weight of war's aftermath, an introduction to the simplicity of homesteading offers respite from the complexities of modern life. The participants were educated on various techniques from the art of starting seeds, foraging, making soaps, and caring for farm animals to indulging in farm-to-table meals. Every moment was a delight for the senses. For spouses of combat wounded veterans, particularly those who bear witness to the invisible wounds of war, homesteading offers a means of reclaiming agency and autonomy.




June 19 - 24, 2024

Warfighter SCUBA Bonfire | Ottawa, OH

Scuba Diving is tremendous for those living with traumatic brain injuries. It requires silence, focus, rhythmic breathing, and calm emotions. Diving quiets the mind and creates surrounding peace. For these reasons the Warrior Bonfire Program works with Warfighter Scuba to provide training and certification at Gilboa Quarry in Ohio. Following all guidelines, medical clearances, and courses through Scuba School International (SSI), participants earn their certification and are now ready for a whole new world of adventures. Camping on this Bonfire Adventure is an added bonus, because much of the day is underwater the camping component allows for lots of communication as they are free of outside noise and electronics.

"I haven't had a smile on my face this big for this long in years!"




June 27 - July 1, 2024

Wisconsin Adventures | St. Croix Falls, WI



On this event our Purple Heart's spend two days of crappie fishing with one-on-one guided outings, followed by learning about the gun-slinging community across the country through a hands on lesson and shooting course using pistols from the 1800's with the Mississippi Peacemakers! The fun continues at Cypress Point Resort, petting and connecting with exotic animals on a safari. Lastly, supported by the Mississippi Department of Wildlife and Fisheries the group experiences clay shooting at the pristine course of Turcotte Shooting Range.



October 17 – 21, 2024

Warrior Pheasant Hunt | Pierre, SD

For more than nine years the Warrior Bonfire Program has partnered with The Ranch Ministries at Korkow Ranch in South Dakota. Not only is this a top pheasant hunting location, it is rich in rodeo history as a top producer of rodeos and bucking stock. The experiences at the ranch are endless. We get to shoot clays in "the ring of fire", race go carts, shoot a Gatlin gun, go fishing, ride horses, view the mustangs and bulls, and certainly, pheasant hunt.

The ranch is a magical place, you are loved like family, with loads of volunteers ready and waiting with hugs, laughter, or a plate of food. Here they face the tragedy of suicide head on and stand ready to battle with you.

Letterkenny Army Depot Deer Hunt | Chambersburg, PA



2. PURPOSE

To honor and recognize the sacrifices made by military members.

3. HISTORY

The Purple Heart was originally called the Badge of Military Merit and was established by General George Washington in 1782.

4. REINSTATED

The Badge of Military Merit was reinstated in 1932 at the Purple Heart Medal.

5. BENEFITS

Purple Heart recipients are entitled to a higher level of Veterans Affairs (VA), medical treatment priority, preference in federal employment and other benefits.
